

Notice is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners of Walla Walla County, Washington, will hold a public hearing at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 3, 2013 in Commissioners' Chambers, Walla Walla County Public Health and Legislative Building, 314 West Main, Walla Walla, Washington to consider adoption of interim zoning regulations or a zoning development permit and building permit moratorium relative to marijuana growing, distribution, and retail, pursuant to Initiative 502.
