- 1. Cascade Natural Gas Walla Walla High Pressure Pipeline / CUP19-005, CAP19-033**
Cascade Natural Gas (CNG) has proposed to construct about 19,900 feet of 6-inch diameter high-pressure natural gas main pipeline. The purpose of the project “is to expand gas services to a portion of Walla Walla County, provide redundancy to the existing gas system, and boost pressures within CNG’s existing system due to usage growth over time.” The pipeline corridor extends through a portion of Section 1, Township 6 North, Range 35 East and portions of Sections 5 and 6, Township 6 North, Range 36 East, W.M. and is within Walla Walla County jurisdiction. Most of the revised project is located within road rights-of-way.

Pursuant to the Governor’s COVID-19 proclamations, this public hearing will be held virtually, by phone and internet. Above is a link that will allow you to attend, listen to, and participate in the meeting by computer. Alternatively, you can call in to participate by phone. However, it is best to join by computer first if you are able, and then have Webex call you directly to use your phone for audio. Contact staff directly for more information about how to participate virtually.

You may also participate by submitting comments in writing by email to commdev@co.walla-walla.wa.us or via the drop-box at 310 W. Poplar Street, Walla Walla. Written comments should be submitted prior to the start of the hearing.

For members of the public without Internet access, the County can provide access to equipment. Please contact the department at least 24-hours in advance to make arrangements.

Cisco Webex Tips:

1. The hearing will be recorded, and the audio will be available on the County’s website after the hearing.
2. Contact CDD staff in advance to test Cisco Webex or make alternative arrangements to participate.
3. The mics for the Hearing Examiner, the Applicant, and County staff will remain on for the majority of the meeting, but all other participants should mute their mics when not speaking.
4. Even if you do not have audio/video capability on your computer and you plan to join by phone, you are still encouraged to join first with a computer. This gives you access to documents being shared. *Also, when you join on the computer you can make an audio selection to have Webex call you. This will link your phone line to your computer and make it much easier to identify you.*
