### TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF WALLA WALLA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

Pursuant to Resolution 14 172 setting a hearing date for the vacation of a portion of Thompson Road right of way, I have examined, along with the County Surveyor, the right of way as described below. In accordance with RCW 36.87, I submit the following report.

ALL OF THAT PORTION OF THOMPSON ROAD RIGHT OF WAY SITUATED IN SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 7 NORTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W. M., WALLA WALLA COUNTY, WASHINGTON.

**USE:** The portion of Thompson Road right of way which is hereby proposed for vacation extends approximately 600 feet into the property of the petitioner, Steve Stubblefield, and comes to a dead end. According to Steve, trespassers use this short segment of road to access his property to dump trash or to steal wood. Once vacated it is Steve's plan to gate off this access. He has already posted "No Trespassing" signs.

CONDITION: Primitive dirt road that receives grader maintenance once a year.

**OPINION:** Said Right of Way is not necessary to the existing County road system and should be vacated.

## OTHER FACTS, MATTERS, AND THINGS OF IMPORTANCE:

Upon review, County staff confirms that said Road is not needed by the Public for future development in the area.

### **Summary**

This claim results from the arrest of Darin W. Mercado on July 6, 2012.

### **Background**

Walla Walla County's insurance carrier, the Washington Counties Risk Pool, has settled a claim made against the County by Darin W. Mercado for \$50,000. WCRP's decision to settle the claim is based on numerous financial considerations, including the high costs of litigation, and does not reflect any admission of liability or wrongdoing on behalf of Walla Walla County or the Walla Walla County Sheriff's Office for any of the allegations contained in Mr. Mercado's claim.

### Cost

The County's financial responsibility for the attorney's fees and claim costs will remain under its \$50,000 WCRP deductible.
