

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST DEPTFORD ADOPTING  
RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE RIVERWINDS ADVISORY BOARD AND  
RECOGNIZING BY-LAWS ADOPTED BY RIVERWINDS ADVISORY BOARD**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of West Deptford, in Gloucester County, New Jersey, has committed to improve the operations and financial status of "RiverWinds" Community Center, and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee has determined that it is advisable to establish an advisory board to work with the Township entities, with other governmental entities, and with citizens to promote and implement financially feasible activities and programs within "RiverWinds", and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee on January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2012 established the West Deptford Township RiverWinds Advisory Board to consist of seven members to be appointed by the Mayor, and

**WHEREAS**, the RiverWinds Advisory Board met on March 19, 2012 and proposed recommendations that were approved by unanimous vote of the RiverWinds Advisory Board. Said recommendations were as follows:

1. Capping membership at 11,300.
2. Open membership opportunities to 250 families who are not West Deptford residents at a rate of \$948 or double the resident family membership rate to the following controlled populations:  
 Gloucester County Emergency Services employees  
 Sheriff's Department of Gloucester County  
 RiverWinds rental groups (such as Tidewater Aquatic and Mullica Hill Tri Club)  
 Sponsored families (RWCC Members in good standing can sponsor a relative or a friend from outside of West Deptford to join).  
 New Jersey State Police  
 Gloucester County Seniors
3. All West Deptford residents will have priority and will not be denied a membership. If all 250 proposed memberships are filled, then a waiting list for non-West Deptford residents will be made by RiverWinds management. The capped membership will be reevaluated periodically by RiverWinds management.

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee considered the written recommendations and analysis from the RiverWinds Advisory Board, questioned RiverWinds Management regarding revenue, memberships, and the proposals, and further heard background given by RiverWinds advisory Board Chairman in support of the Board's recommendations and the By-laws adopted by the RiverWinds Advisory Board;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, after having considered the written recommendations and support, the comments by RiverWinds Management and the RiverWinds Advisory Board Chairman, the Township Committee adopts the following recommendations:

- 1 Capping membership at 11,300.
- 2 Open membership opportunities to 250 families who are not West Deptford residents at a rate of \$948 or double the resident family membership rate to the following controlled populations pursuant to fee ordinance:  
  
Gloucester County Emergency Services employees  
  
Sheriff's Department of Gloucester County  
  
River Winds rental groups (such as Tidewater Aquatic and Mullica Hill Tri Club)  
  
Sponsored families (RWCC Members in good standing can sponsor a relative or a friend from outside of West Deptford to join).  
  
New Jersey State Police  
  
Gloucester County Seniors
- 3 All West Deptford residents will have priority and will not be denied a membership. If all 250 proposed memberships are filled, then a waiting list for non-West Deptford residents will be made by RiverWinds Management. The capped membership will be reevaluated periodically by RiverWinds Management.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, The Township Committee recognizes the RiverWinds Advisory Board By-Laws adopted by the Board on March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2012 and will support such a further ordinance to empower the By-laws should it be determined a further ordinance is needed.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the written recommendations and support submitted by the RiverWinds Advisory Board along with the RiverWinds Advisory Board By-laws are incorporated and hereby attached and made part of this resolution.

**ADOPTED** at a regular meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of West Deptford held on April 12, 2012.
