WHEREAS, Derrick Kearney remained with Ms. Hickman and controlled her bleeding and attempted to gather information about the attack and/or suspect; and

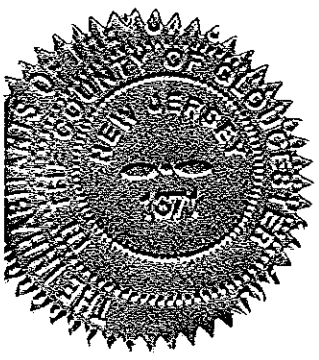
