

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST DEPTFORD
AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL
SERVICES BY A LICENSED SITE REMEDIATION PROFESSIONAL**

WHEREAS, there exists a need for a Licensed Site Remediation Professional for the Township of West Deptford; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that funds are available for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Township of West Deptford, prior to the award of this contract for "Professional Services," has complied with the dictates of *N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5*, and its Ordinance establishing a Fair and Open Process for the Award of Professional Service Agreements and Other Agreements with Business Entities adopted pursuant thereto, requiring that all contracts for "Professional Services" be awarded pursuant to a fair and open process; and

WHEREAS, the Township of West Deptford has awarded this contract for "Professional Services" after undertaking to consider all proposals submitted pursuant to the Fair and Open Process required by *N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5*, and the Township's Ordinance establishing a Fair and Open Process for the Award of Professional Service Agreements and other Agreements with Business Entities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of West Deptford, Gloucester County, New Jersey, as follows:

1. That the firm Pennoni Associates be and is hereby appointed Licensed Site Remediation Professional for the Township of West Deptford effective July 12, 2012 for the balance of the year ending December 31, 2012, as per the terms of an Agreement, and the Mayor and Township Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement on behalf of the Township of West Deptford pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5*, and the Township's Ordinance establishing a Fair and Open Process.

2. A Notice stating the nature, duration, service and the amount of the contract and that this Resolution and agreement are on file and available for public inspection in the office of the Township Clerk shall be published in *The Gloucester County Times*.
