**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST DEPTFORD  
AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A SHARED SERVICES  
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER  
AND THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST DEPTFORD  
FOR THE PROVISION OF A TRANSPORTATION BUS**

**WHEREAS**, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, *N.J.S.A.* 40A:65-1 through 35 (the "Act"), authorizes local unit(s), as defined in the Act, to enter into an agreement with any other local unit(s) for the joint provision within their jurisdictions of any service which either party to the agreement is empowered to render within its own jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of West Deptford ("Township") is a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Gloucester ("County") is a body politic and corporate of the State of New Jersey; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has the authority and responsibility to provide bus transportation within the Township of West Deptford; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has the authority and numerous buses in connection with transportation for disabled persons, elderly individuals and bus services for other residents with the County of Gloucester; and

**WHEREAS**, due to an unexpected fire involving the Township's bus, the County has agreed to provide said transportation services to the Township on a temporary basis.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of West Deptford, County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey on this 15<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2012, that the Mayor and/or Township Administrator are herein authorized to execute on behalf of the Township of West Deptford and Township Committee the Shared Services Agreement as briefly described above, and in the form attached hereto and incorporated herein.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**; that the Mayor and Township Administrator are herein authorized to take any and all action necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution.
